



Volunteer position: Acting Captain

Description of position

The title of Acting Captain is given to personnel who have previously served as a Responder during a probationary transition period to Captain. Acting Captains serve with Incident Response and are responsible for responding to accidents, disasters, natural disasters and other emergencies.

Duties of position

The duties of an Acting Captain may include: Responding to disasters, natural disasters, and occasionally accident scenes to provide support to injured persons and emergency personnel, serve as Incident Commander, complete incident reports, other duties as assigned.

Requirements for position

The requirements for the position of Acting Captain: Must be a minimum of 18 years of age, must have a cell phone, must pass a criminal record check in the vulnerable sector, must be physically fit for duties, must have completed Recruit and Responder terms or have previous experience in emergency services or other qualified agency/organization.
