



Volunteer position: Responder

Description of position

The title of Responder is given to personnel who have completed their Recruit term.

Incident Responders are responsible for responding to accidents, disasters, natural disasters and other emergencies.

EMRD Responders are responsible for attending events.

MPAD Responders are responsible for assisting in SAR operations.

LPT Responders are responsible for LPT field operations

Duties of position

The duties of an Incident Responder may include: Responding to disasters, natural disasters, and occasionally accident scenes to provide support to injured persons and emergency personnel.

The duties of an EMRD Responder may include: Attending events, setting-up equipment, checking inventory, patrolling event grounds by foot, or ATV, providing on-site first-aid, contacting EMS or Police in situations that require either or both services, other duties as assigned.

The duties of an MPAD Responder may include: Attending SAR operations and searching for missing persons.

The duties of an LPT Responder may include: Attending reports and searching for lost pets, picking up found pets and dropping them off at a partner organization.

Requirements for position

The requirements for the position of Responder: Must be a minimum of 18 years of age, must have a cell phone, must pass a criminal record check in the vulnerable sector, must be physically fit for duties, must have completed Recruit term or have previous experience in emergency services or other qualified agency/organization.
